From the Scholarship Committee...

Each year the 100 Club of Alameda County awards college scholarships to sons and daughters of officers or firefighters killed in the line of duty. Named for Sheriff Charlie Plummer, former Sheriff of Alameda County for 5 terms, the scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, and associated expenses at an accredited institution of higher education. Over the last 10 plus years that we have been providing this scholarship, many students have graduated with the financial help the 100 Club provides.

We currently are providing scholarships to 3 students. In the next 10 years, we will be awarding the most scholarships in any 10 year period. 14 children will be turning 18! We currently award up to \$57,000 for a 4 year college and \$9,000 for community college. We are very proud of our scholarship program and very proud of our students. This program is just one of the ways your membership dues help family members.
