CA Highway Patrol Officer John Miller



Officer John Miller was killed in an automobile accident on Friday, November 16, 2007 while searching for a reported drunk driver.

The officer was driving south on North Livermore Avenue about a mile north of Interstate 580 when he lost control of his patrol car around a sharp curve and struck a tree.

Officers from the Livermore Police Department located the drunken driving suspect, on eastbound I-580 near Greenville Road, and he was arrested by the California Highway Patrol on suspicion of DUI, evading police, and driving without a license.

Officer Miller had served with the California Highway Patrol for one year and was assigned to the Dublin Area Office.

He is survived by his wife and two children.

Two board members met privately with the family prior to a "Bell Ringing" ceremony at the CHP Academy in Sacramento to deliver the check and our condolences on Monday, November 19th.
